## Hindi Retreat 2013

Academic Programme (Provisional)

The programme will consist of three panels with twelve 90-minute sessions in each. For each session, participants are expected to read 4-5 pages of Hindi. In the sessions we will have a close reading of the passages and translate them into English, which eventully allows participants to translate them into their languages, if they wish so. Texts will can be discussed in various levels, including, difficult phrases, language, style, narrative strategies, cultural embeddedness, etc. The medium of discussion can be either Hindi or English, as suits the individual participants. Participants will be free to take all three panels or opt for any combination of them.

## Panel 1 — theatre

Panel 2 Susham Bedi's writings (led by Susham Bedi, Columbia University, New York)

Selections from *Maimne nāṭā toṛā; Havan* (novels); *Avasān, Saṛak kī lay* (short stories); *Kyā hai ghar mere liye?*, *Pravāsī sāhitya kī asmitā kā savāl* (essays). Poetry by Bhavānī Prasād Miśra and others from *Dūsrā saptak*—and by Nirālā from *Parimal* — 12 sessions

Panel 3 Short stories and poetry (four sub-panels of three 90-minute sessions each)

- d) Kuṇāl Simh: *Premkathā mem moze kī bhūmikā kā ālocnātmak adhyayan* (led by Alessandra Consolaro, Torino)
